

Employee Misconduct Registry/ Nurse Aide Registry Check

The State of Texas Administrative Code, under TITLE 40, Part 1, Chapter 93, Rule 93.3, as amended on September 1, 2010, as well as Chapter 253 of the Texas Health and Safety Code prohibits the hiring of an individual who is listed in the Employee Misconduct Registry and the Nurse Aide Registry as having abused, neglected, or exploited a resident or consumer of a facility or misappropriated a resident's or consumer's property.

Before you are hired, and annually thereafter, your name will be checked against the State of Texas Employee Misconduct Registry and the Nurse Aide Registry. If you are listed on either of these registries, you are ineligible for employment.

I understand that my name will be checked and certify that I have not been listed as having abused, neglected, or exploited a resident or consumer of a facility or misappropriated a resident's or consumer's property.
